



Kudos to our president Ana Pettit who recently received the Volunteer of the Month recognition from the Arlington



Police Department. Her citation said she is one of the most active of their Community Watch Group volunteers. In November, when she was alerted that a suspect had set fire to a house and was last seen riding a bicycle, Ana continued to observe the partially burned house.

She eventually saw the suspect sitting in the front yard.

Ana called 911 and officers apprehended the suspect. In addition, she asked her neighbors to cover the damage enough so that the disabled mother of the suspect could return to the house. The citation says that Ana went "above and beyond"



and through her "diligence and determination a suspect is off the streets."
