



#### Awards


Our congratulations go to Alan Austin, Class of 1969. He has been named the Woodrow Counts AISD Teacher-of-the Year. The Arlington Kiwanis Club has chosen the honorees every year since 1962. Each school selects a teacher-of-the-year for their campus. The club chooses three district-wide honorees for elementary, junior high and high school. Named a Distinguished Colt Alumnus in 2005, Alan teaches U.S. History and AP U.S. History. Alan began a three generation line of Austins at Arlington High. Distinguished Colt Alumna Jannette Workman, AHS '54 and chair of the Kiwanis Club's committee announced his honor to Alan at AHS.



More scholarship news: Our scholarship program began with a proposal to the Association from Jannette in 2003 and two \$600 stipends. This year we will give \$20,000 to ten '23 grads. Your gifts and dues made this happen. Thank you, Colt Alumni! Distinguished Colt Alumnus John Gardner, Class of 1957, established a scholarship in honor of his class. Over the years, many '57 alumni, in addition to John, have donated to that scholarship administered by Arlington High School. We will keep the spirit of the Class of 1957 alive by awarding the Class of 1957 Scholarship.


