**Location: Getting to Gym B** 



Double Door entry, First hallway to the left south side of building



Take second hallway



Through those doors and a few more steps to Gym B!

- 1. Enter parking lot on Cooper Street.
- 2. Park on the south side of the school near the baseball field.
- 3. Facing the school, enter the double doors on your left.
- 4. Take the first hallway to the left.
- 5. Proceed to second hallway and turn right.
- 6. At end of hall, go up ramp or steps, pass through triple doors.
- 7. Entrance to Gym B on the right

Easy access ramps go up every incline alongside steps. Tables and chairs will be on gym floor. (You won't have to sit in bleachers!) Balloons and student guides will help you find your way. A good sound system will be in use, too.
