If you think the Open House is nothing but tea and cookies, get an inside look from **Ray Roberts, '48**, who attended his first in 2010. In a letter to **Mac Martin**, Ray reminisced a bit about his early departure at 15 from AHS into the Air Force, and the encouragement he received from James Martin as his career led him to leadership in Virginia school systems. As a sojourner in many lands, Ray's return to AHS—even though it wasn't "his" campus—was an event he doesn't want to miss again.

"I wish there was a way I could thank everyone who attended the AHS open house function. This is the **real** "America" and I wish this type of a function could happen in every town.

We had a history teacher at AHS, a former WWII

pilot who encouraged me to join the Marine Reserve unit at Dallas NAS so I could have an ID and uniform. I got in at 15! My career took me to Germany, Virginia, and Vietnam, but I always regretted the loss of my last years at AHS.

After the function last Saturday, my wife Linda and I drove by the old AHS building. I was shocked. It was no longer a red brick building and the flag pole where we always met is now part of the street. But the spirit and drive of AHS Alumni is alive and well and I am happy to be permitted to be part of the group. Thanks to you and all who worked so hard on the function. It was tremendous. We look forward to next year and hope to see you at future Association events."

One event each year at Open House is the "unveiling" of the Distinguished Colt Alumni for the year. Although a second presentation of the honorees takes place in the fall at Homecoming, the late Colonel **Neel Kearby, Class of 1928**—named Distinguished Colt in 2010—was the centerpiece of another unveiling in November. Thanks to the efforts of city leaders and dedicated admirers of Kearby, most of whom are AHS grads (**Lana Ward Wolfe, Richard Aghamalian, Clete McAlister—all Class of 1965**), a statue of the famous WWII flying ace and a Texas historical marker (championed by **Geraldine Nash Mills, '59, and Wanda Roberson Marshall, '51**) was dedicated on the west side of the George Hawkes Central Library.

Tommy Vandergriff, Class of 1943, named Distinguished Colt Alumnus in 1997, died December 30. Read the words he wrote in June 1948—words which can still ring true (except for the amount of dues)—to Arlington High School Alumni. At right is a portion of his letter in the inaugural AHS Ex-Students Bulletin in which he articulated our mission perfectly.

Dear Colts,

The purpose of the Association is just what we think you want it to be: to promote Arlington High School. Surely this motive will challenge every alumnus. Surely the unselfishness of this purpose will win for the Association high regard on the part of the public and personal satisfaction on the part of every ex-student....Send that dollar in as dues. It is your way of saying “YES” to the question: “Do you want to be an Ambassador of Good Will for your school?” Let us all work together to the end that our Association will become a permanent and ever more worthwhile service.

Congratulations: Robert Miles, '57, was honored by his peers at two addiction treatment centers late last year. Grapevine Valley Hope awarded him their Golden Heart award during their annual celebration—Oct’sober’fest—in recognition of his efforts to help those in recovery from addiction, his advocacy in legislation and for speaking out for active addicts who can’t speak for themselves. In November, he was given “The Pillar of the Community Award” at the Gratitude for Giving breakfast at the Mansion on Turtle Creek sponsored by Sierra Tucson. 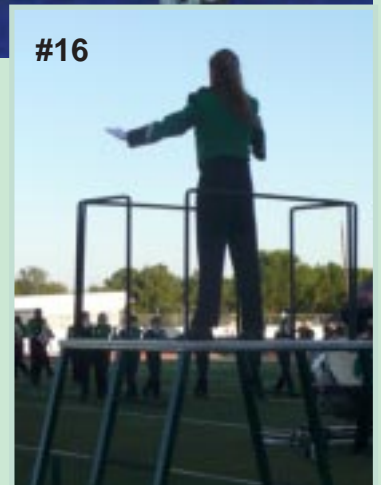

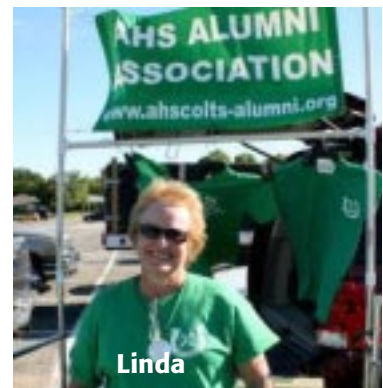
